The April 23, 2019 order for an evaluation provides the August 12, 2019 Friend of the Court Recommendation and Proposed Order will be binding on the parties if no objections were filed within 21 days. The Recommendation and Proposed Order was served by mail on the parties on August 12, 2019. No objections were found in the record.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

**Suspension of Parenting Time and Treatment Provisions**

Avram will have no contact with his mother until the following is achieved:

Alexandra will present herself to the FOC for evaluation.

Upon evaluation, she will provide documents attesting to her current mental condition, including the current treatment provider and the current treatment plan.

Once evaluated, there may be a return to the supervised order now in place.

However, should her recovery be on track but not sufficient for supervised contact, a bridge to that contact may take place. Such a bridge may include some Face Time. All of this assumes, however, Alexandra is not living with Somangshu.

**Parents' Communication**

Somangshu will not reply to any inappropriate communications that appear to be the product of Alexandra's mental illness.

**International Parenting Time**

Parenting time will not be exercised in a country that is not a party to the Hague Convention on the civil aspects of international child abduction unless both parents provide the court with written consent to allow a parent to do so (MCL 722.27a(9)).

**Legal Residence and Change of Domicile**

The domicile or residence of the minor may not be moved from Michigan without the approval of the judge who awarded custody or the judge's successor. The person awarded custody must promptly notify the Friend of the Court in writing when the minor is moved to another address. A parent whose custody or parenting time of a child is governed by this Order shall not change the legal residence of the child, except in compliance with section 11 of the Child Custody Act of 1970, 1970 PA 91, MCL 722.31
